These Terms and Conditions form a contract between you (referred to herein as “you”) and Woolgoolga Surf Lifesaving Club (“WSLSC”) for the right to access the features and functionality of the Clubhouse.

Through your registration of WSLSC and acceptance of keys to access the Clubhouse you acknowledge that you have read and understand these Terms and Conditions and will comply with them.

These Rules are made by the Executive Committee (“Committee”) effective 25 June 2020 and may be reviewed and amended as required. These Rules are intended to give effect to the current Constitution/By-Laws and should be considered as an Addendum to those Rules. These Rules remain in operation until replaced or repealed.

## **1. Interpretation**

- a. Any ruling by the Committee’s interpretation of these Rules is final and conclusive for the purposes of the matter in respect of which the ruling is made;
- b. These Rules should be considered as an Addendum to the Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) Membership Application and Declaration and the Surf Life Saving New South Wales (SLSNSW) Club Guide;
- c. Where these Rules are silent, reference should be made to the SLSNSW Club Guide;
- d. For the purposes of these Rules, the term Clubhouse shall refer to the entire building, its’ rooms, sections, facilities and environs unless otherwise specified in any particular Rule.

## **2. Access to Clubhouse and Usage Restrictions**

- a. Subject to these Terms and Conditions, WSLSC grants you use and access of the features and functions of the Clubhouse using uniquely assigned electronic keys;
- b. Keys/electronic access will be granted only to financial members. Non-financial members will have their electronic access deactivated without notification;
- c. Some areas of the Clubhouse will have restricted access. Your allocated keys/electronic access tag will be pre-programmed to reflect this;
- d. Lost or misplaced key/electronic access tags shall be replaced at a fee fixed from time to time by the Committee;
- e. Keys/electronic access tags are for the sole use of the member to whom they are issued and shall not be transferable;
- f. WSLSC reserves the right at any time and from time to time to modify, discontinue, or suspend, temporarily or permanently, its offering of access to the Clubhouse without notice or liability to you or any third party;
- g. The rights to use the Clubhouse shall terminate upon breach of this Agreement by you. You agree and understand that WSLSC may terminate this Agreement at any time, with or without cause. Upon termination of this Agreement for any reason, you agree and understand that the rights to use the Clubhouse shall terminate.

## **3. CCTV Cameras**

- a. Agreement to these Terms and Conditions also constitutes agreement to the WSLSC CCTV Cameras Policy (attached);

#### **4. Club Property**

- a. No member shall remove, or use for any purpose other than that for which it is intended:
  - i. Any lifesaving, competition or carnival gear of the Club without approval of the Committee;
  - ii. Any other property of the Club without the approval of a member of the Committee or designated representative.

#### **5. Gymnasium**

- a. Only members over the age of 18 and who hold a current Gymnasium Membership are permitted to access and use the gymnasium area and equipment contained in that area;
- b. Gymnasium members are not permitted to invite or provide access to the gymnasium to persons who are ineligible under 5a;
- c. Members shall comply with the 'Gymnasium Rules' as displayed within the gymnasium;
- d. No equipment to be removed from the Gym without prior approval of the Committee;
- e. Gymnasium members shall promptly report any damage or malfunction of equipment to the Committee;
- f. A member under the age of 18 years shall not use the Club gymnasium except under the direct supervision of an adult Active Member.

#### **6. Changerooms, Toilets and Showers**

- a. Toddlers only (under the age of 4 years) are permitted in opposite gender change rooms, toilets and showers only under direct supervision of their parent/guardian at all times. At a minimum, swimwear is to be worn by the toddler while in the opposite sex facilities;
- b. Children over 5 years are not permitted in the opposite gender change room, toilet, or showers under any circumstances;
- c. Toddlers and children must be accompanied by their parent/guardian when using the change room, toilet or showers. They should not be left to their own devices;
- d. The disabled toilets may be used as a "family change room/toilet" facility for parents with toddlers or children;
- e. Toddlers or children are not allowed to change in public places of the Surf Club;
- f. No mobile phones, cameras or recording devices are permitted to be used within the change rooms, toilet or shower areas;
- g. Sunday mornings during the summer months are the busiest periods of use for the change rooms and shower facilities. These facilities are for the use of all members of the club, young and old. Patience and consideration is requested of all members when using the facilities at these times.

#### **7. Wet Costumes**

- a. A member shall not wear a wet costume in the Clubhouse except in the wet entrance, the change rooms, the shower rooms, the toilets, the boat shed, craft shed or the gear room;
- b. Members returning to the Clubhouse from the beach with wet costumes or bodies must utilise the wet entrance at the beach side of the building.

## 8. Cleanliness

- a. Each member shall take all reasonable action to preserve the cleanliness of the Club
- b. Members entering the upstairs functions area of the Clubhouse shall ensure that they are dry and completely free of sand. When the upstairs functions area is used for emergency surveillance, compliance with this Rule shall be the responsibility of the Duty Officer. When the upstairs lounge is used for training and education purposes, compliance with this Rule shall be the responsibility of the relevant trainer/assessor/facilitator (TAF);
- c. Members using the kitchen or barbecue area shall ensure that it is left clean after each use.

## 9. Children

- a. A child under the age of 13 years, other than a member, shall not be permitted to enter the Clubhouse unless accompanied by a member;
- b. A member who accompanies a child so as to have the child permitted to enter the Clubhouse shall adequately supervise the child at all times while the child remains in the Clubhouse.

## 10. Animals

- a. With the exception of service animals, no animals shall be permitted in the Clubhouse.

## 11. Bicycles

- a. Bicycles are to be secured on the external bicycle racks;
- b. No bicycles are to be kept within the confines of the Clubhouse at any time.

## 12. Visitors

- a. A member who brings a visitor/s on to the Club premises shall gain permission from the Committee and at the first opportunity, introduce the visitor to an officer of the Club;
- b. A member shall be responsible to ensure that the visitor, while they remain on the Club premises, conforms to these Rules as if they were a member.

## 13. Accommodation

- a. A member shall not reside, or allow another person to reside overnight in the Clubhouse without the prior approval of the Committee.

## 14. Training

- a. The Director of Lifesaving, Director of Surf Sports, Director of Education, Duty Officer or Committee may at any time require any part of the Clubhouse to be available for drill, training, instruction or other purposes connected with the work of the Club;
- b. No games or other forms of amusement shall be permitted which interfere, or tend to interfere, with any such drill, training, instruction or other purpose in progress.

## **15. Conduct**

- a. A member shall not, in the Clubhouse, engage in unseemly conduct such as bad language, bullying, harassment or other forms of misconduct likely to interfere with the comfort of other members.

## **16. Misconduct**

- a. Any member violating the SLSA and WSLSC Constitution or these Rules, or who misconducts themselves on Club premises or elsewhere, or who acts contrary to the general policy of the Club or so as to bring the Club into disrepute, may be suspended or expelled from the Club by the Committee or may otherwise be dealt with as the Committee deems fit.

## **17. Smoking**

- a. Smoking in the Clubhouse and within a 4-metre vicinity is prohibited.

## **18. Liquor and Prohibited Drugs**

- a. Intoxicating liquor shall not be consumed on Club premises in contravention to the Liquor Licence granted to the WSLSC;
- b. A member shall not come on to Club premises under the influence of intoxicating liquor;
- c. No prohibited drugs shall be brought on to the Club premises;
- d. A member shall not come on to Club premises under the influence of a prohibited drug.

## **19. Publicity**

- a. A member shall not, without the approval of a member of the Committee, supply to the media any information concerning Club activities;
- b. Where possible, all media interviews or contacts in regard to life saving, competition or training activities of the Club shall be dealt with by the Committee;
- c. Members will comply with SLSA's Social Media policy.

## **20. Club Administration Staff**

- a. Members must ensure that their conduct meets SLSA's Policies & Procedures regarding each Member's behaviour towards the administrative staff, whether paid or voluntary administrative staff.

## **21. Membership Fees**

- a. The membership fees are listed in Schedule A, and will be reviewed by the Committee annually.
